## Islampura slum got school and brought bright future for the children



Islampura slum is in Ranibennur town. Total over 500 families are living here. Muslim and other backward families are in more number.. Beedi (home made cigarette) works is the major occupation for muslim community. Most of the children were sent to hotel, assistant in garage, assisting masons/mortar, hamali (labor) in business shops etc., for earning. These families never bothered about children health, education and their future life.

VRDS organized 12 SHGs and conducted different training and discussion on their problems. During the time the parents realized that we are not sending our children to school.

Organization helped in formation “Slum Development Sangha” and motivated them to work on the welfare of slum residents. The first issue was taken by the sangha is children education. The listed that how many children are not going to the school and found that 36 children were away from school education. Slum development sangha wrote to District

Administration for sanctioning school to Islampura slum and also made appeal to Karnataka Child Right Protection Committee.

The issue reflected the failure of Universalisation Education programme of Government in the heart of Ranibennur town and drawn attention of District Administration, District Judge, Education Department and the public. With all the efforts Islampura slum got sanction government school for the children.

Ku.Shameenabanu Tinmaker is very happy and says that I am getting free uniform, text book, shoe, tie etc., and learning with happily. All the children are also getting midday meals, sports, drawing, signing and learning with enjoying.
